- (iii) That the GPC bring a proposal to the December SGM for the establishment of a Working Group with a remit to consider further academic initiatives in the context of the legacy of slavery.

The College considered, but did not agree:

- (iv) That permission be sought from the relevant authorities to remove the Codrington Statue.
